## **Reports & discussion:**

- Penny & Dan (BRSG) described their experience. Their group was in existence for 18 months before they achieved charity status in January 2017. They have a Chair, Trustees, and between 15-20 supporters actively involved. Community sponsored families; independent group. Their aims are similar to those of LRSG: support families; send aid to camps in Greece & France; provide holidays for refugee children (yet to be started)
- Two families settled: June 2017; March 2018
- Interpreters: Exeter University is a good contact. Pay for time and for travel hours. (£10 hour) Be prepared to adjust who works with family. As interpreters have access to all the family's business it can cause tension.
- BRSG allocated £15K to each family (amount estimated to support for two years)
- The family (-ies) will be complex; won't necessarily get on. Respect their views/reactions.
- Vital that women have female GP and female interpreter. Try to access NHS dentist.
- BRSG pays 'top-up' of £115 pw for rent, as housing benefit is capped.
- Open a bank account with the family; help with establishing a budget.
- Funding: through regular donations (FB page) = £350 pm

- Local groups support; e.g. % of sales at events; teas/coffees at events.
- Some larger donations from benefactors.
- Structure: Lead co-ordinator; befrienders responsible for different aspects (e.g. health appointments; benefits & job centre; social; activities with the family; baby-sitting) Lead co-ordinator draws up a weekly schedule.
- Have a structure for all involved. Don't write up every meeting; coordinators to log concerns (mostly to do with children)
- Trustees have decided to restructure meetings: monthly for those involved with the family only; open general meetings every three months.
  Protects confidentiality & allows befrienders to share and peer support.
- We need to know what structure we want, and what CC require.
- DBS through CC; £12; existing DBS are acceptable.
- Policies published on the BRSG website.
- Cultural differences. Prepare: talk & support. There is a huge spectrum of experience. Attitudes to Moslems and different values from within and without are wide and complex, and need to be discussed and managed.
- Advice: the group can 'have a say' and set criteria for the family to be allocated. This is important.
- Housing: Rebecca, and later Frances, frustrated by response from CC officer visiting the house. Hope pinned on the return of Serena to post; she has greater understanding and empathy. Frances to pursue decisions on housing and on allocation of family.

# **Business:**

Finances: We have £8872.75 in the account.

**Charity status**; there has been a delay; responses to specific questions have been sent and we await a further response.

Volunteer database setup & questionnaire: on hold but Roger overseeing this.
